## PROJECT PURPOSE

The Global Art Project creates Peace through Art by:

Connecting people around the world who choose to create and share a vision of global peace

Creating a living network of cooperation that can help to make the vision of peace a reality

Focusing on the value of the arts as a pathway to understand the world as it is and to imagine how it might be

Connecting people of diverse cultural backgrounds, providing exposure to new ideas and a feeling of connection to the Whole

Healing feelings of separation while helping to show that the world can be safe for diversity

Exemplifying in concrete form that people can be different and unique yet act together as integral members of one living organism — Earth.

## Create

March, 2018

People around the world who choose to participate will each create a work of art expressing their vision of global peace. The art may be in any medium — visual or literary art, audio or videotapes, etc. — which can be sent from one person or group to another.

## Display

April 1-22, 2018

The art will then be displayed locally in each person's community. Participants may submit documentation of their work to GAP for inclusion in the Art Bank of Global Peace.

## Exchange

April 23-30, 2018

GAP will then organize a worldwide exchange. All at once, around the world, the visions of global unity will travel from one person to another—visions of peace simultaneously encircling the Earth.



# How To Participate in the Global Art Project

1.

First

Register online or send your name, address, and donation (\$15 US for individuals, \$20 US for groups, if possible) to GAP postmarked by **February 28, 2018**.

GAP will match you with another person or group.

2.

March

Create a work of art expressing your vision of global peace. You may document your art and the people who created it to be included in the GAP Art Bank.

Label the documentary materials with name, address, medium, and size. Send it to the GAP address. Materials will not be returned.

3.

April 1-22

Display/share your work locally in your own community. This could be on the walls at work or school, in a hospital, a public library, gallery, bank, local café, or restaurant — wherever you feel comfortable sharing your vision. You may want to join together with a group of participants to find a place where you can display or perform your work together.

4.

April 23-30

Exchange your art with the person or group with whom you have been matched. The art you receive will be yours to keep, and likewise, the art you send off will be kept as a gift of global friendship. Please include a photo of yourself and a personal note.

5.

And finally

As a completion of the Global Art Project, you may choose to display the art which you received so that the people in your community will have an opportunity to experience the diverse visions of global peace.
